



PRODUCER GUIDELINES FOR SLAUGHTER

June, 2011

Before you bring your poultry or rabbit for slaughter:

1. Make sure you have booked your slaughter date and that it has been confirmed with you. In most cases, we will be unable to service drop-ins.
2. Birds with full crops cannot be processed. This means you must remove all feed from the poultry for 12 hours prior to processing. Poultry should still have water during this time.
3. When you bring your birds or rabbits to slaughter they must be alive and in good condition.
4. CCIPPA reserves the right to refuse to slaughter any bird or rabbit that is not in good condition.
5. Birds and rabbits should be transported in cages that allow the livestock to be transported in good condition and where the livestock can be maintained in good condition until such time as slaughter occurs.
